MANN SCHOLARSHIP was established by his wife MARCIA KAPLAN-MANN in order to provide higher education scholarships for Eagle Scouts of the Greater New York Councils who have demonstrated strong Scouting and community involvement.

EAGLE SCOUTS GUIDELINES TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR CONSIDERATION

1. Be an Eagle Scout and currently registered with the GREATER NEW YORK COUNCILS, BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA. Special consideration will be given to Eagle Scouts employed on the Ten Mile River Scout Reservation Summer Camp Staff.
2. Have demonstrated participation in activities outside of Scouting.
3. Be accepted by one or more accredited colleges or universities. You may first apply as a high school senior and may also apply subsequently while studying at the college undergraduate level.
4. Submit an essay of approximately 200 words on "What Scouting means to me."
5. Submit a 100-word essay concerning your college and career goals.
6. At least two (2) letters of recommendation must also be submitted. (One academic letter, one Scouting letter from individuals who know the applicant personally).
7. Understand that receiving a grant in one year does not guarantee a grant in the following year. A Scout is welcome to reapply each year with all required letters and the essays. Priority will be given to Scouts pursuing at least twenty-four credit hours during the school year.
8. Complete this application form in full, and return it no later than June 1st.
